 - Consultation of experts in the registration process, or not
 - Process of delimitation of geographical areas
 - Ways to solve the problems of pre-existing rights, problems of co-existence between prior trademarks and GIs



Points to be discussed (3)

- Controls and certification : credibility and consequences by the consumers
 - Controls and certification modalities: which are the main and specific difficulties in the developing countries ?



Points to be discussed (4)

- Collective management of the GI's and antitrust and competition laws
 - Which are the current stakes ?
 - Which are the specific needs in this topic for a better development of the GI's ?



Points to be discussed (5)

- Rural Development policies and GI's
 - Which kind of RD policy measures are able to re-inforce the GI's impacts on the territories ?
 - Identification of good case studies



Points to be discussed (6)

- In which way the consumers protection is helping the development of geographical indications
- Are the GI's a credible sign for creating a trust relations between the consumers and the producers ? Under which conditions could it be the case in the future ?

- Which are the consequences of the heterogeneity of the GI's and the GI's protection system on the extension of the protection under TRIPS Agreement ?
- Which are the consequences of a lack of a multilateral registration system ?
- Which is the compatibility between the national legal frameworks and the articles 22-24 of the TRIPS agreements ?
