
Socio-technical qualification of the beef meat origin

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PDO Taureau de Camargue



• Two breeds « raço di biou », « de combat » or cross breed



- 92 breedings in PDO area
- Genetics selection based on capacity for bull-fight and not for meat production
- Wild bull = heifer + cow + Bull

First and only french PDO for beef meat

Bad conformation of the carcasses

Links between activities From disqualified carcasses to qualified meat

Collective agreement between breeders and butchers on Specific technical system :

- creation of a code of practices
- definition of carving operations, specific grid of classification
